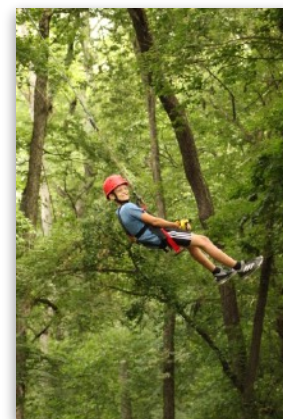
Summer 2024

Generator Upgrades

After losing power multiple times this summer and having our Dining Hall standby stop working, we are raising funds for some much-needed generator upgrades! It will cost around \$20,000 to replace the Dining Hall generator, add a standby to our North Panel, and replace our old mobile generator. Some money has already been provided, so **we need about \$11,000 more**. Our goal is to significantly improve our ability to care for campers and staff through the power outages we experience so frequently.
